Very soon after starting my career in real estate, I realised I had the desire to create their interior rather then selling the end product on the market.



The spectacle of thousands of Swifts, Swallows and Martins feeding over the water during peak fly hatches is one of the delights the summer visitor. 30 acres of the woodland are ancient in origin and spring flowers include carpets of Bluebells and Stitchwort.


