Highlighting the online environments tendency towards echo chambers. Echo chambers limit exposure to diverse perspectives and have been known to increase social and political polarization and extremism.

expose your mind -

Visitors exit through a narrow tunnel, the voices from each of the chambers can be heard mingling together. This symbolises breaking free of an echo chamber by being open to alternative voices and seeking out opposing views.

diversity fades

The further in to the garden visitors venture the more the diversity in planting fades. All you are left with is the strong, dense repetition of Cupressus sempervirens.

the first chamber

The first echo chamber can accommodate multiple visitors. Their voices mingle and echo and their reflections move out of time with one another across the walls. There is diversity in both the audible and visual landscape.

a single perspective

With space for only one, only the voice and reflection of the individual are echoed back again and again. The illusion of many voices when there is only one being amplified and distorted.

losing sight

The paths view beyond the garden shrinks as banks of stone gradually tower over it.

entrance

Visitors enter through a generous path surrounded by a diverse & open wild flower meadow.
