




Planting plan

RESIDENTIAL - FAMILY HOME, TWICKENHAM




OVERVIEW OF THE CONCEPT

Inspired the Boglione family home at Petersham House, this design aims to bring "La dolce vita" to Twickenham. COOKING AND DINING TERRACE

A generous limestone (Ref A, B) paved terrace positioned to enjoy afternoon and evening sun. Wooden cooking area with Green Egg BBQ and reclaimed brick pizza oven (Ref C). Antique marble and metal table (Ref E) to seat 8-10 people.

Oak bench seating under oak pergola for morning sun. Storage built into bench.

FRONT GARDEN

Front door flanked by 2 Cupressus sempervirens trees. Limestone herringbone paving (Ref B). Planting wrapped around car parking space including 3 pleached Malus 'Evereste'. Green roofed bike and bin storage.






BRIEF

To transform the large ~1700m² "quad" space from a bleak outdoor corridor into a green epicentre, where the diverse Priory School community (pupils and staff) can relax, learn and play.

OVERVIEW OF THE CONCEPT

Once a busy marshalling yard, the local "Railway Land" nature reserve in Lewes is now crammed full of wildlife, bringing nature to the heart of the town. This design aims to connect the school with this unique local initiative, referending the textures, shapes and colours of railway environments. Beautiful and practical outdoor spaces have been created without comprisiming on ease of movement between the school buildings.






ELEVATION OF SOUTH SIDE OF QUAD

BRIEF

To create outdoor spaces that are fit for a modernist architectural masterpiece and that enhance the lives of residents of the flats and gallery visitors.

OVERVIEW OF THE CONCEPT

Inspired by early modernist interiors, and particularly the textile artist Annie Albers, the design balances functionality and simplicity with warmth and playfulness. It references the shapes seen in Albers work - "stringent geometries offset by a sense of spontaneity and movement" and celebrates her obsession with the "tactile sense".



BACK AND SIDES OF BUILDING

Two pergolas (Ref C) define spaces to socialise, work and relax in. A rill runs around the building, fed by a pond on the south side. The strict grid paving at the front gives way to a more informal pattern.(Ref D).

ROOF TERRACE

The long narrow space is divided into three distinct rooms. A frameless glasshouse (Ref E) subtely references the shape of the iconic stairwell as well as providing room to grow plants.









ELEVATION OF FRONT OF BUILDING (NOT TO SCALE)












