Seating circle with stools made of stumps.

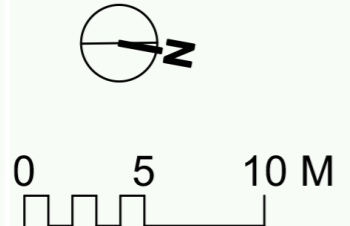
Gazebo for bird watching and relaxation.

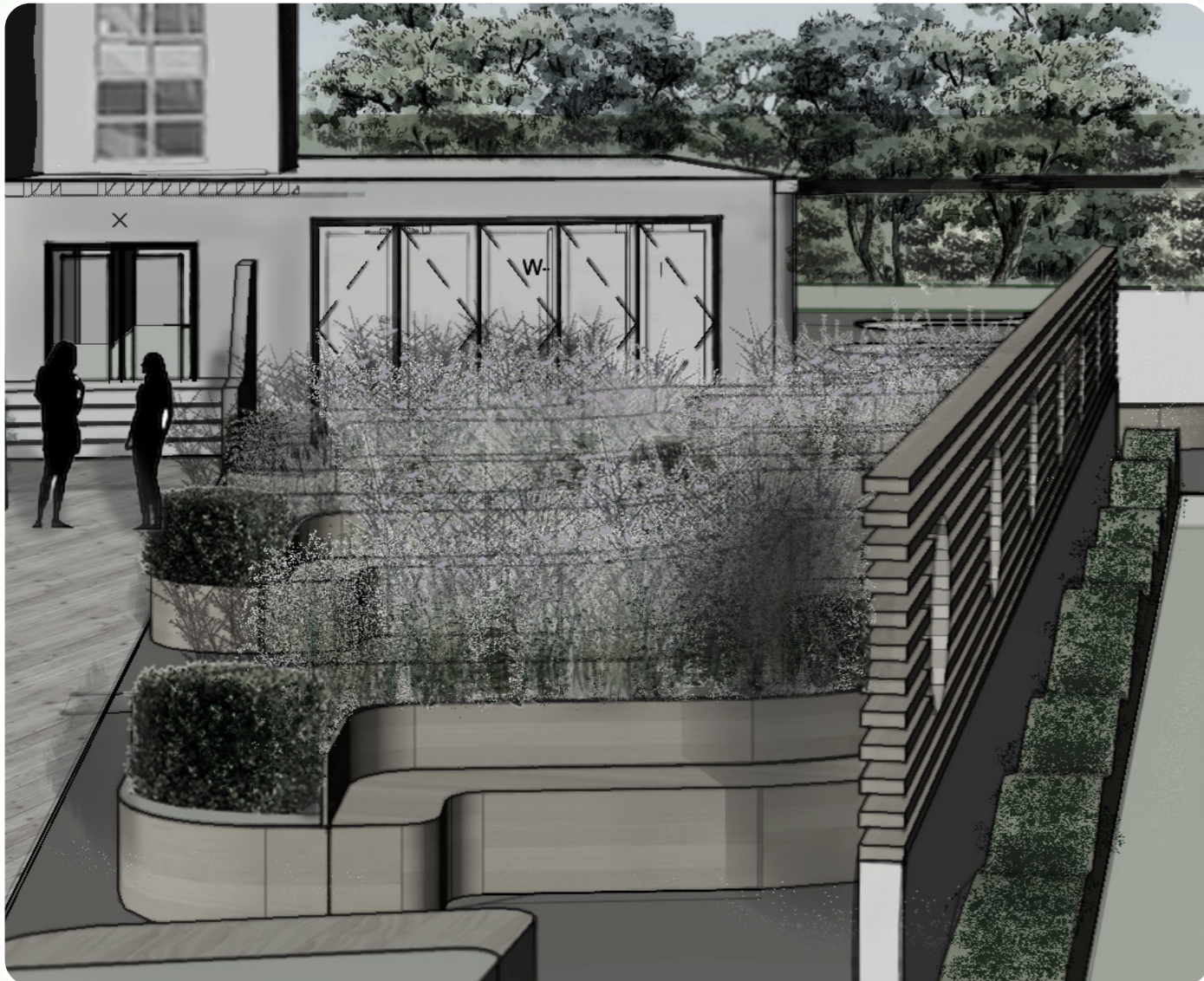

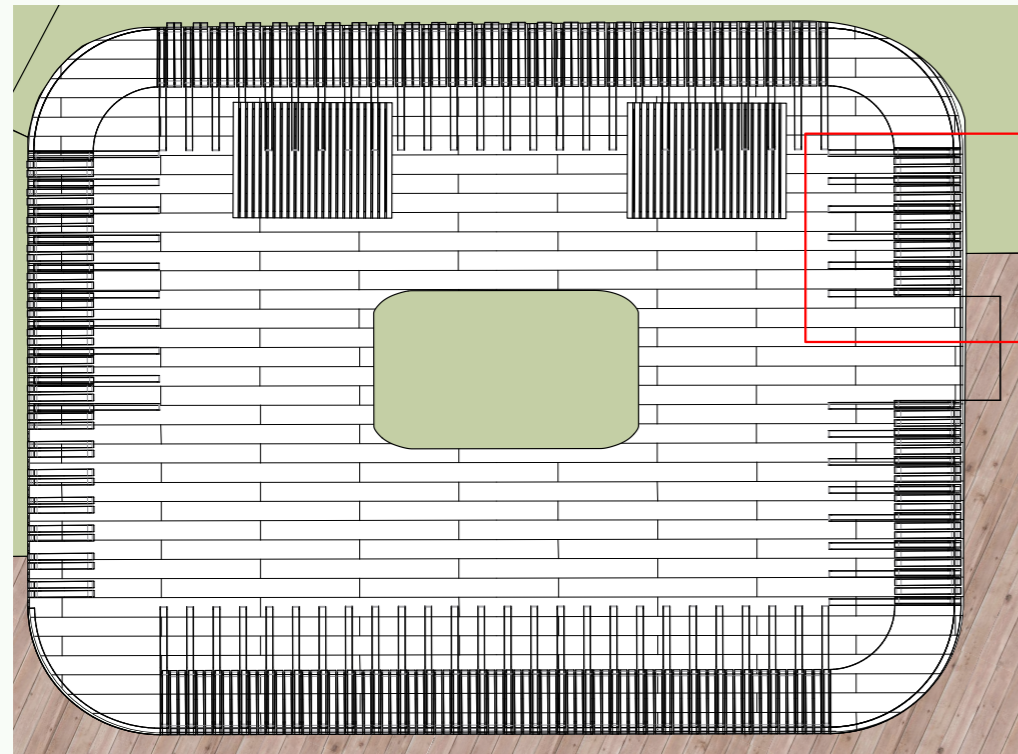

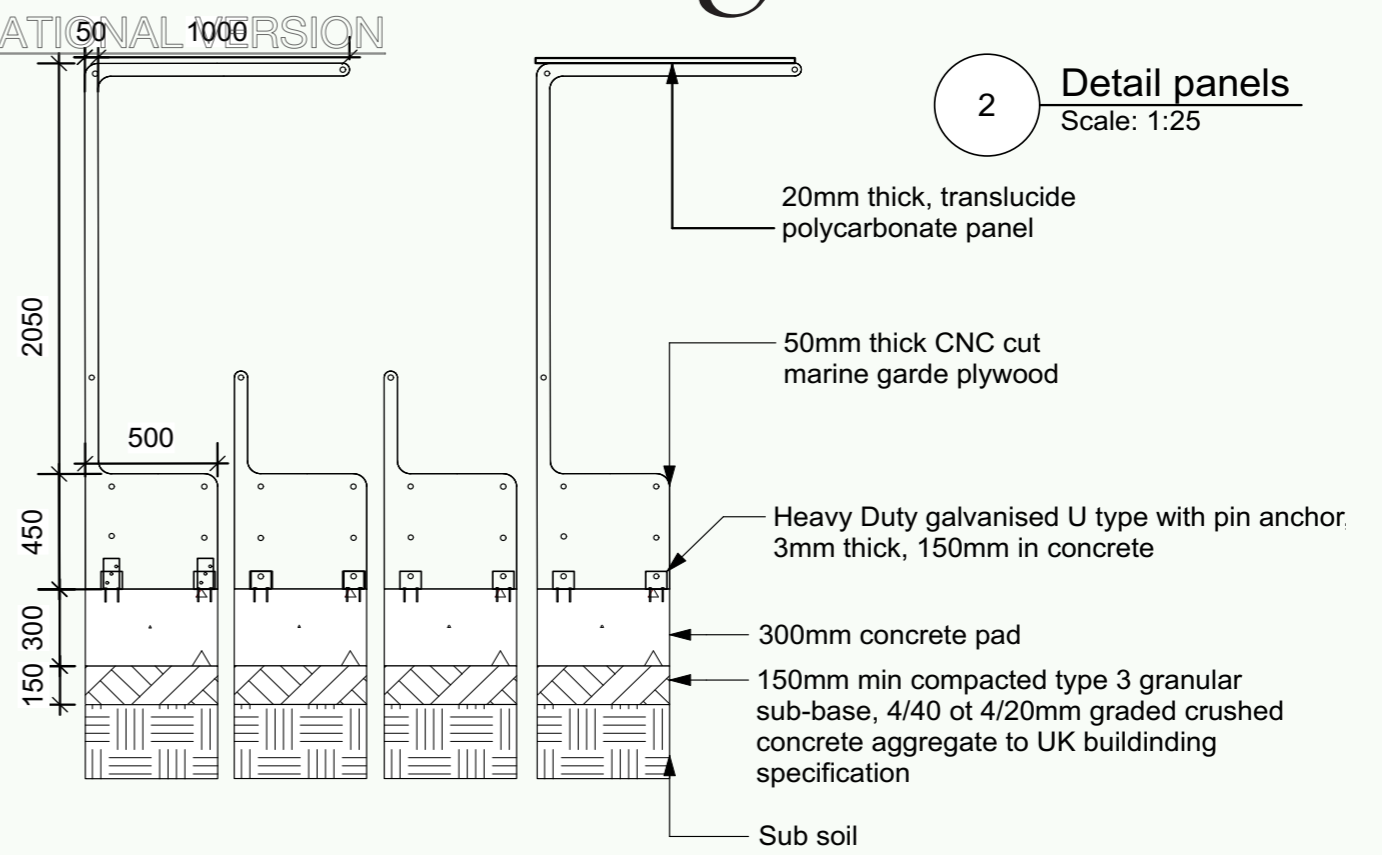

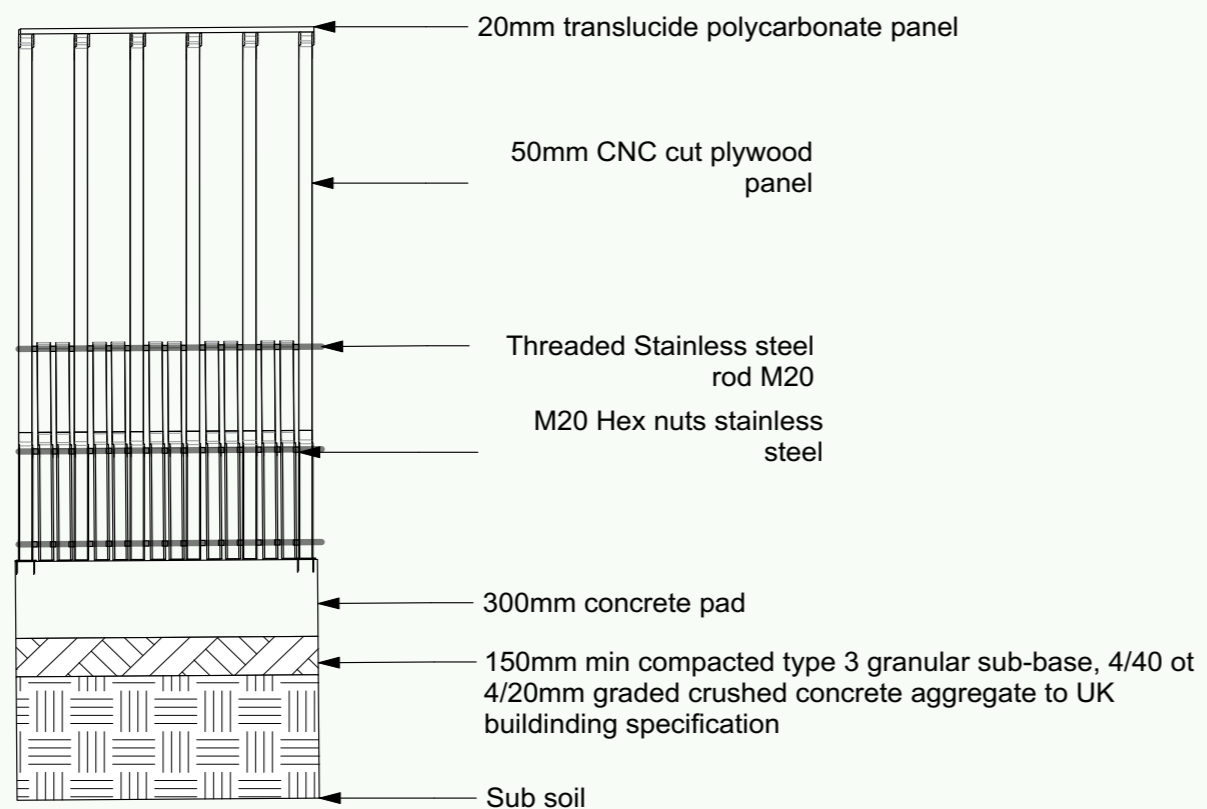

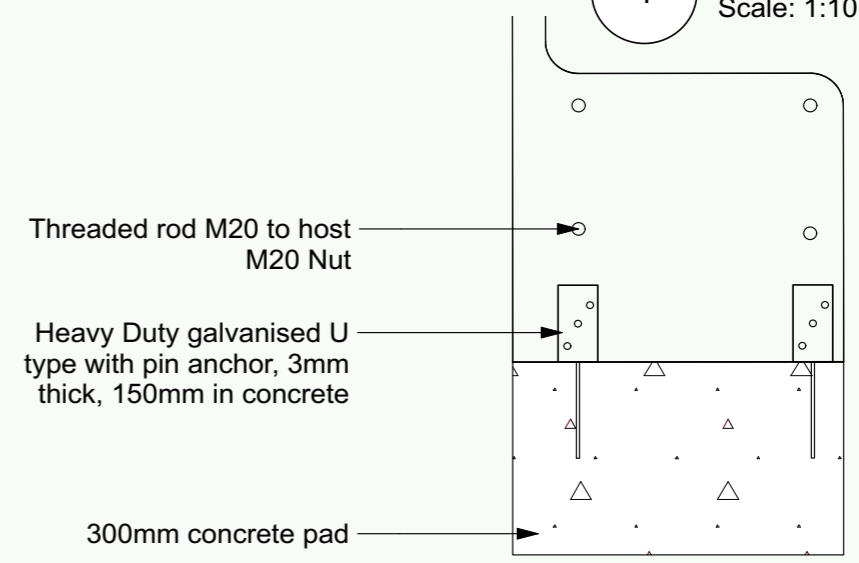
2 **Detail panels**

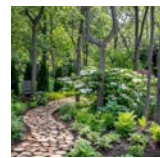

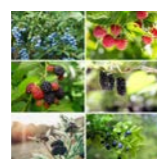

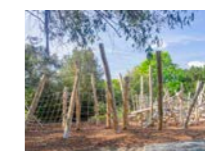

Back Garden: Create a calming space for rest and relaxation. An enjoyable space to read a book, do yoga, meditate, socialise with friends and enjoy.

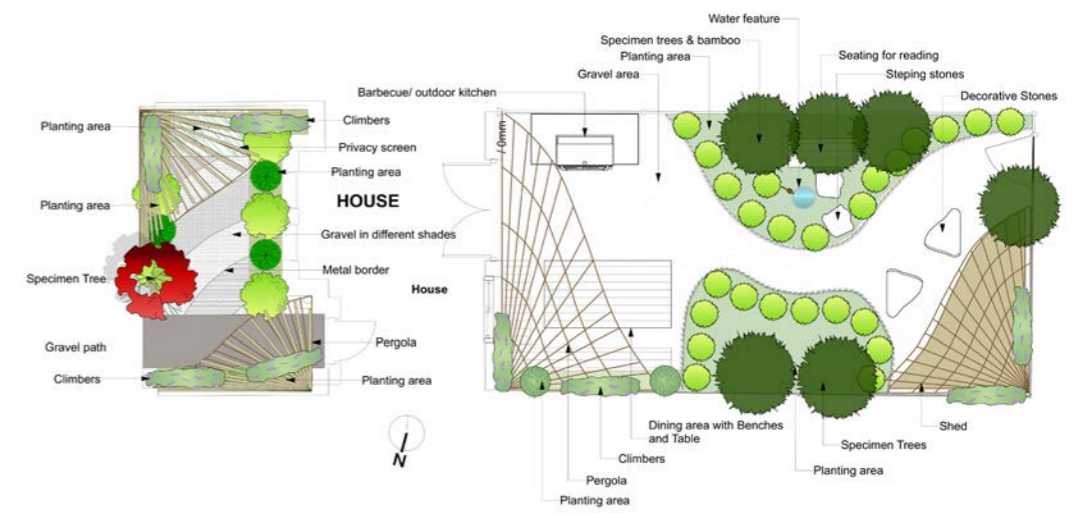

Show Garden: Category Global Impact

Global Impact Gardens demonstrate how plants and design can address the hot topics we face today in a creative and show-stopping way. Whether it is a social, economic or environmental issue that affects the individual, minority, majority or all of us, Global Impact Gardens act as a platform for conversation.

Design intention:

Over-consumerism with “modern agricultural practices” led to the fast deterioration of soil in agricultural areas with the depletion of its organic content.

Traditional agricultural techniques have used manure as a natural fertiliser adding organic matter to the soil improving soil structure, aeration, moisture-holding capacity, and water infiltration. And this practice also favours bio-diversity.

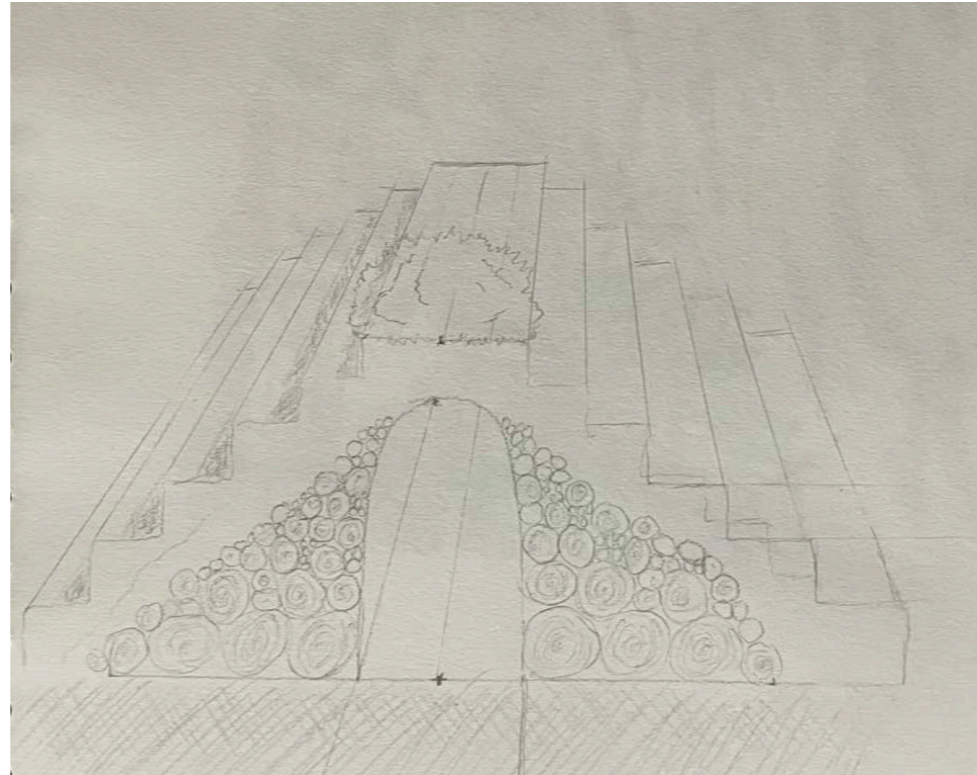
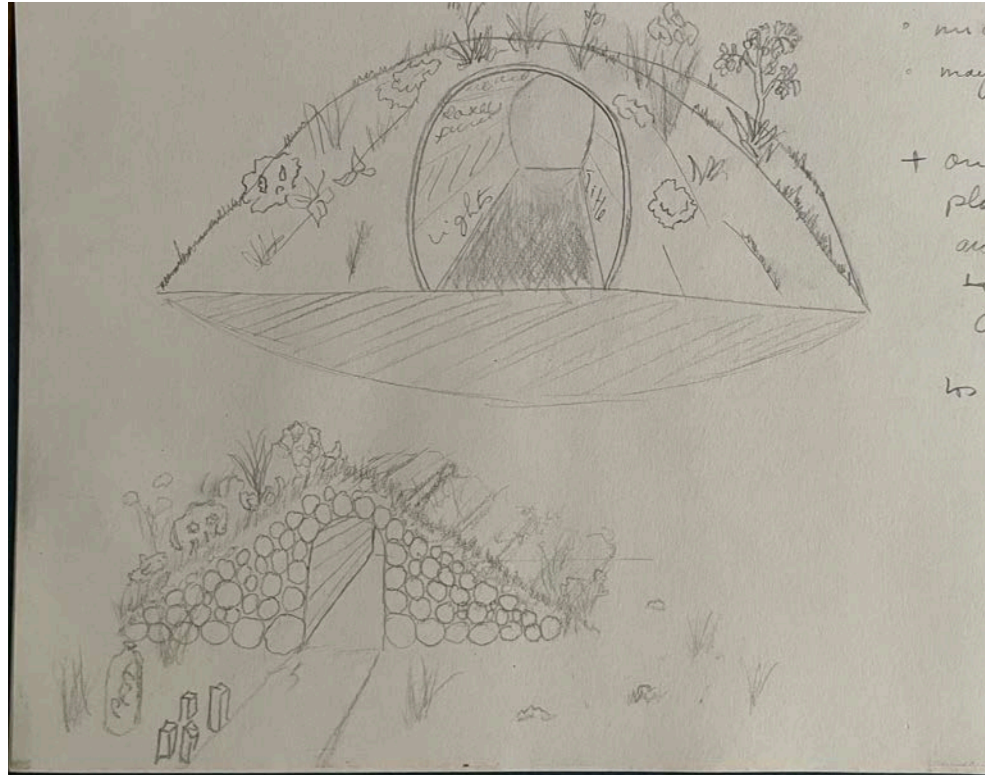
In a society of super-sized everything to meet our demands maybe a solution is a super-sized pile of organic fertiliser in a super-sized traditional hugelkultur bed.



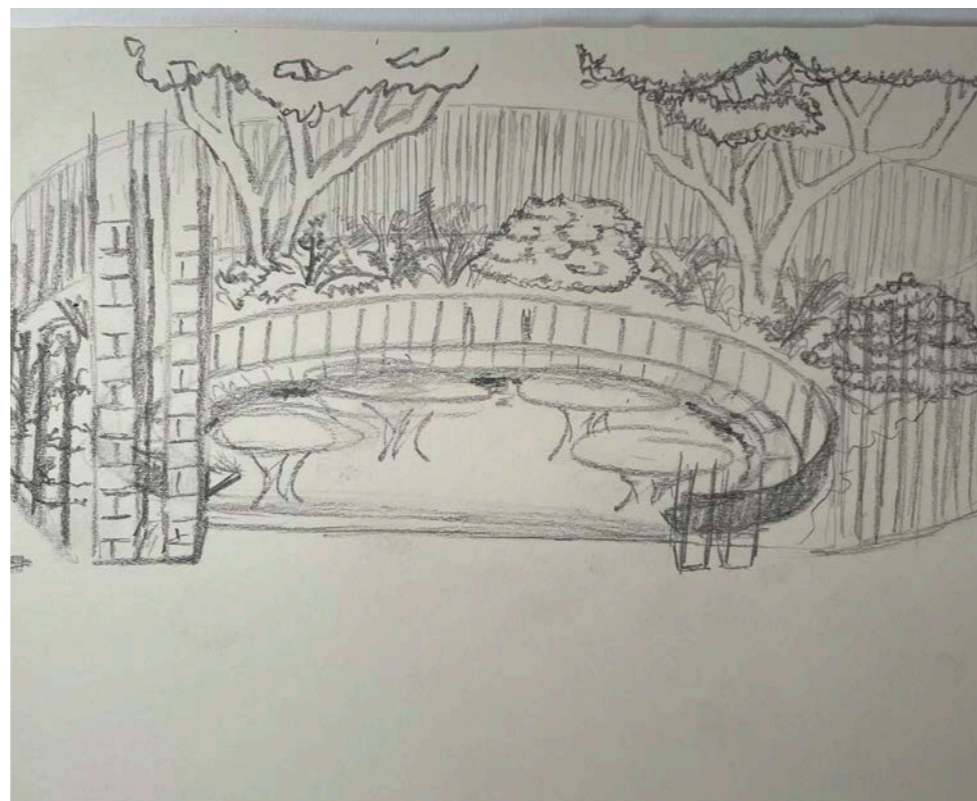

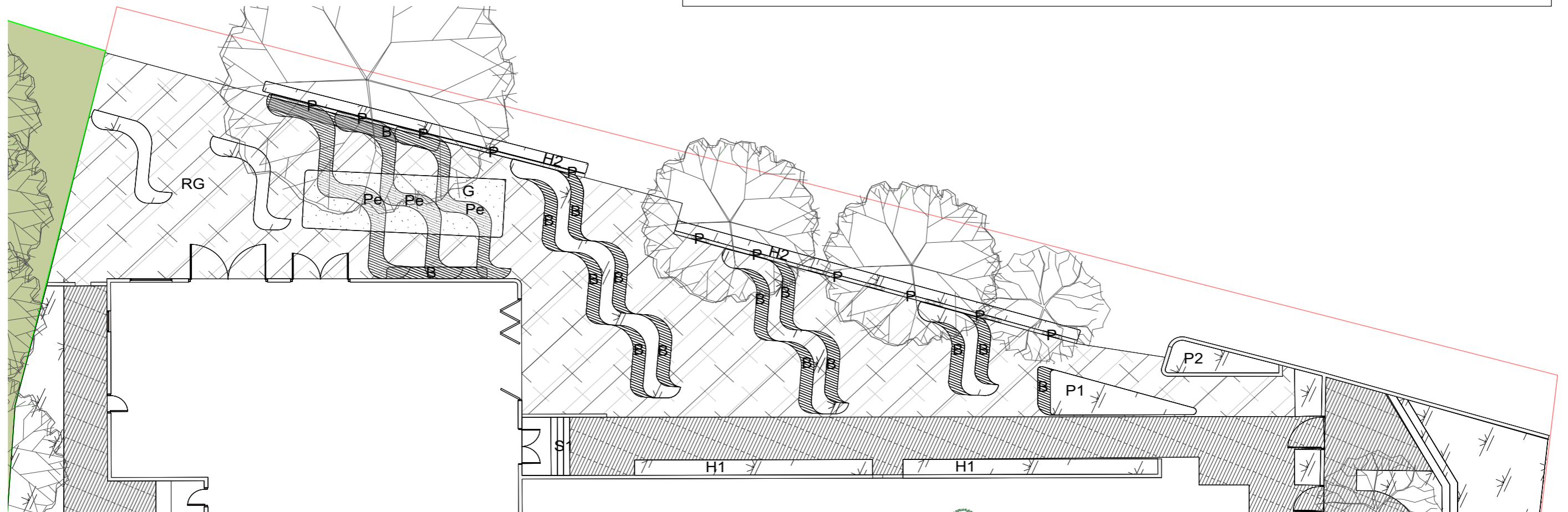
