
Front Garden: Create privacy, make it part of the home, becoming a feature somehow.






Planting Plan and Elevation


Design intention:

Over-consumerism with "modern agricultural practices" led to the fast deterioration of soil in agricultural areas with the depletion of its organic content.

Traditional agricultural techniques have used manure as a natural fertiliser adding organic matter to the soil improving soil structure, aeration, moisture-holding capacity, and water infiltration. And this practice also favourites bio-diversity.


In a society of super-sized everything to meet our demands maybe a solution is a super-sized pile of organic fertiliser in a super-sized traditional hugelkultur bed.




