Floating pavilion designed to sculpt evening light onto inner walls, positioned at Equinox. Sunken firepit to extend evening light, aligned with Winter Solstice.

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







SAXON MEADOWS GENERAL ARRANGEMENT

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Landscaping which uses on-site waste or local materials.

Flint, brick, charred timber.

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Sand-set bespoke pavers using brick rubble from site in low-carbon concrete mix. See Local Works Studio for reference.
Laid in stretcher bond with 2-3mm nominal joints filled with sand. Angle to change according to path and curve around edges.
Refer to design details. 250mm x 100mm | 40mm thick.

Sand-set bespoke pavers laid within turf. Pattern to be laid in line with stretcher bond, arranged on site by designer.
250mm x 100mm | 40mm thick.

Sand-set reclaimed brick pavers from site. Laid in stretcher bond with 2-3mm nominal joints filled with sand.
Angle to change according to path and curve around edges. Refer to design details. Varied sizes.

Bespoke concrete circular pad formed using brick rubble from site in low-carbon concrete mix.
To sit flush with pavers on top of rill. Must be aligned with both front doors to houses.
4000mm diameter | 40mm thick.

Benches using charred timber set into granite boulders. Details to be discussed with fabricator. $700 \text{mm} \times 2000 \text{mm} \mid 600 \text{mm}$ height



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Lighting which creates consistent atmosphere while keeping levels at a minimum. Bollard lights, wall lights, inset floor lights.










