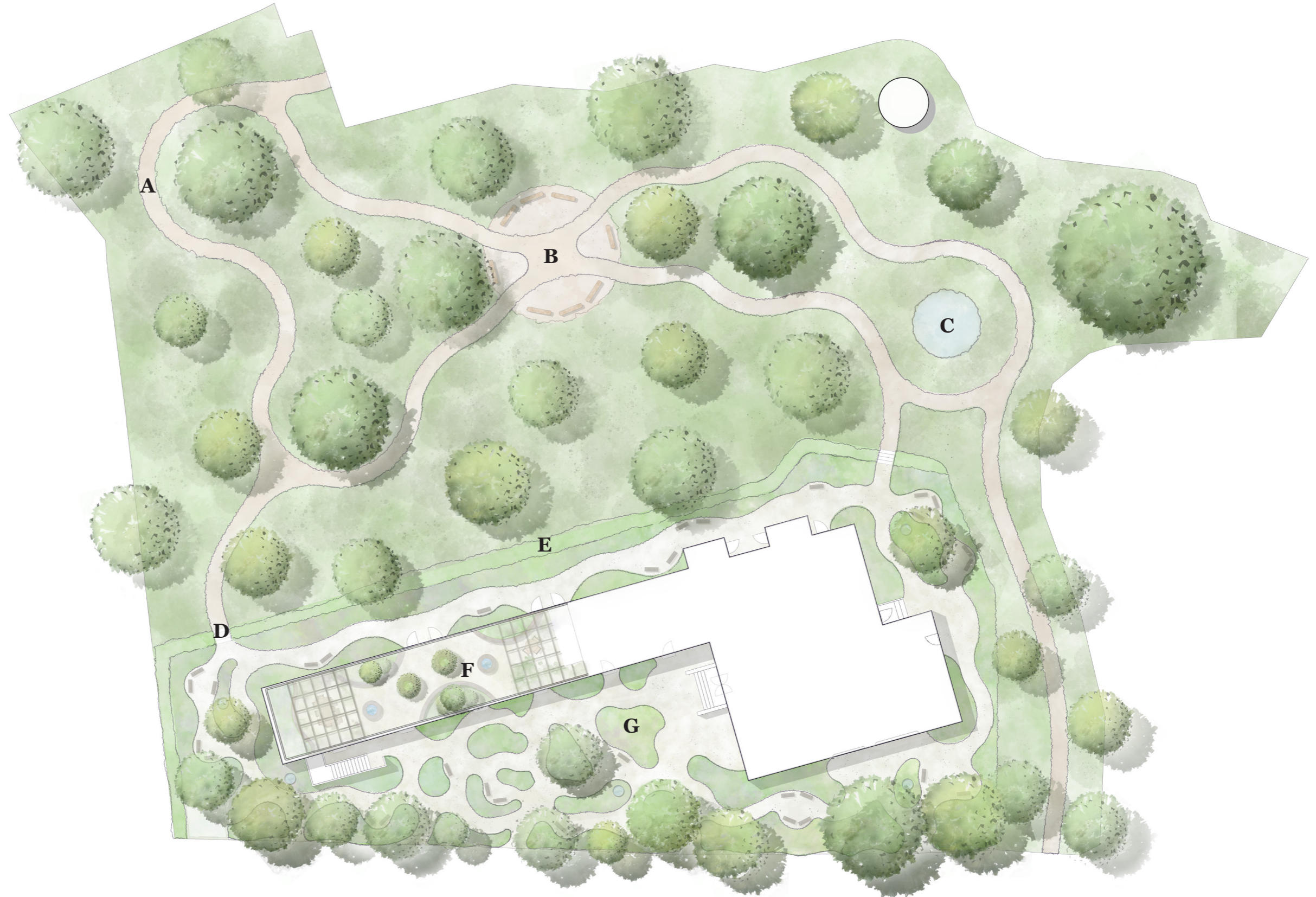

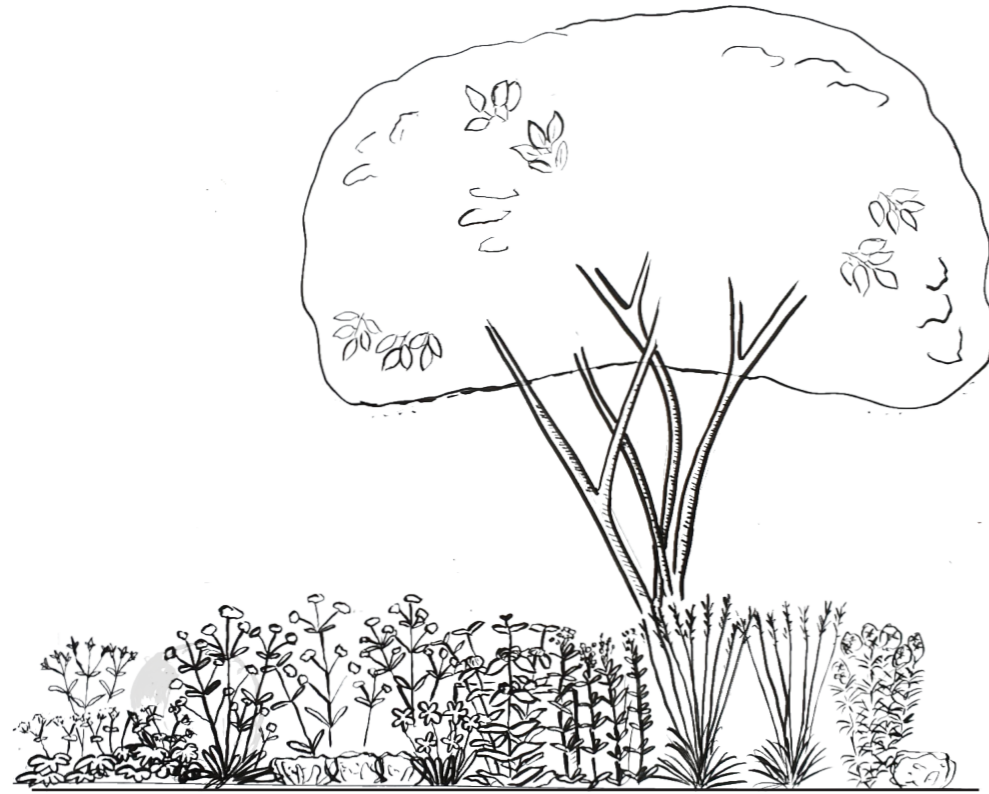

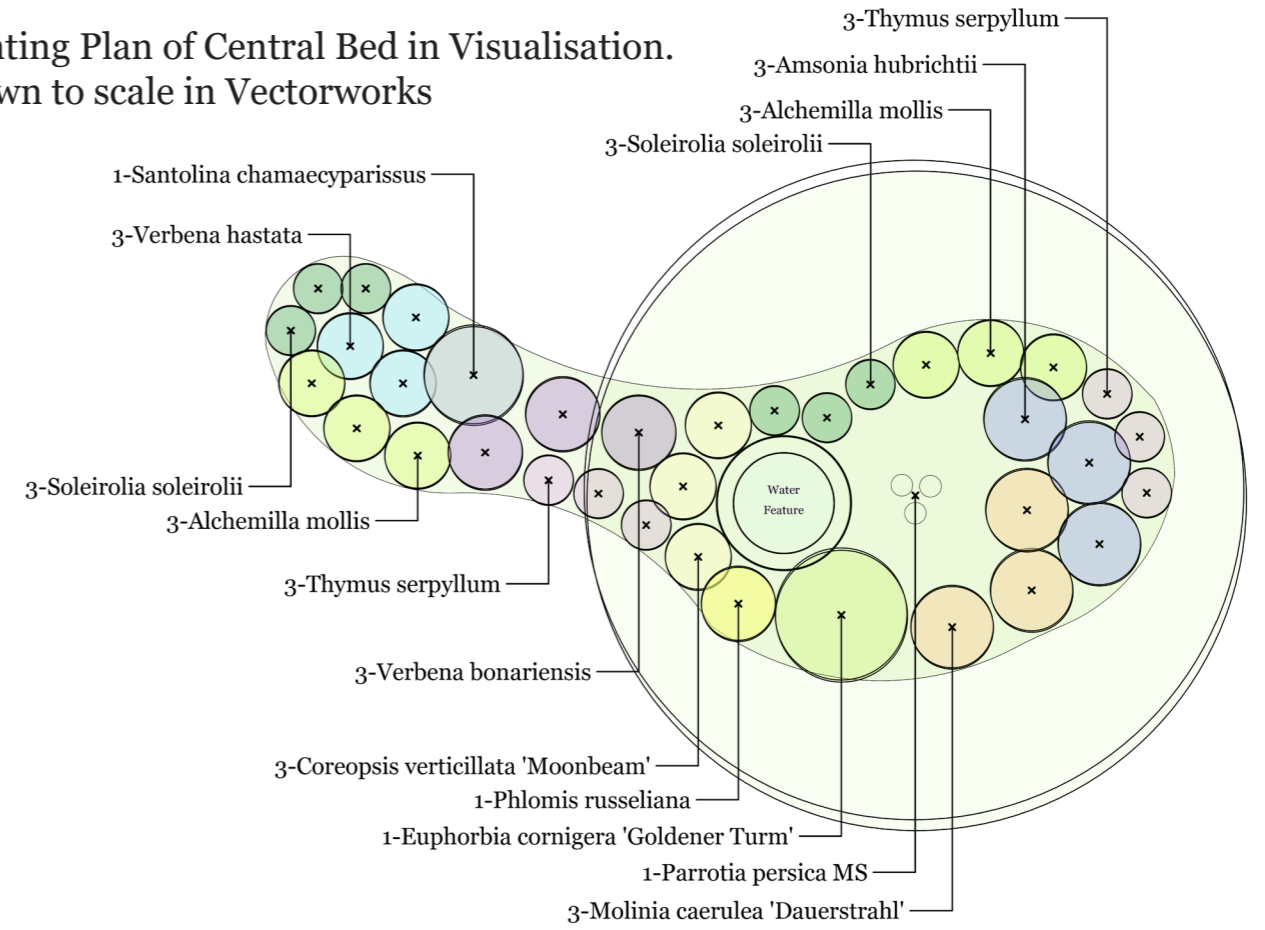
Elevation Drawing of Central Bed. Hand drawn to scale

Therapeutic Social Garden - Lewes Priory School's Staff Courtyard

BRIEF

- To provide the staff with a space to relax and socialise.
- To improve mental health and emotional well-being.

CONCEPT

- Inspired by the Chapel on the site, decking is used to 'bridge' the site's history with the present.
- Options for private and open areas, allow meetings and socialising.
- Plants and materials are chosen for therapeutic and mental health benefits, with natural properties.

B - Raised decking ramp into the space

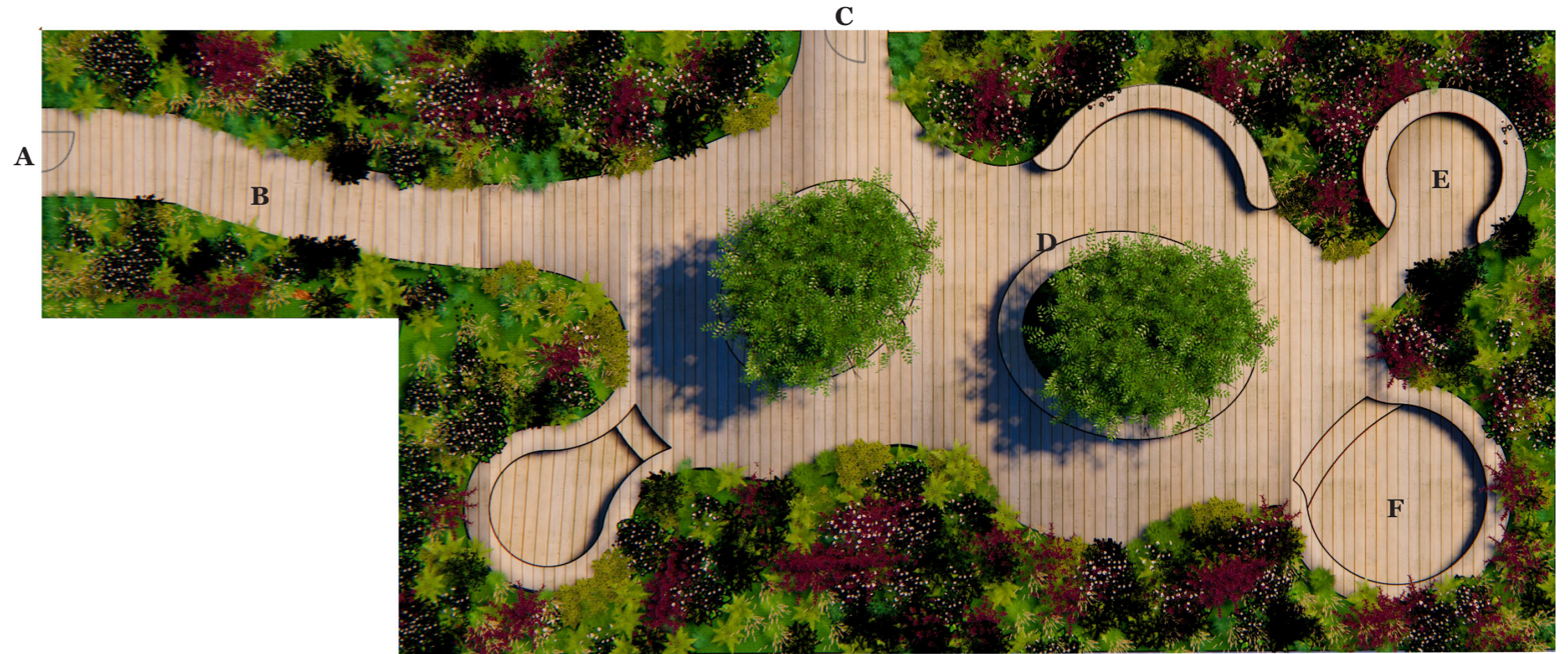
C - Door to the Staffroom

F - Sunken private seating for meetings

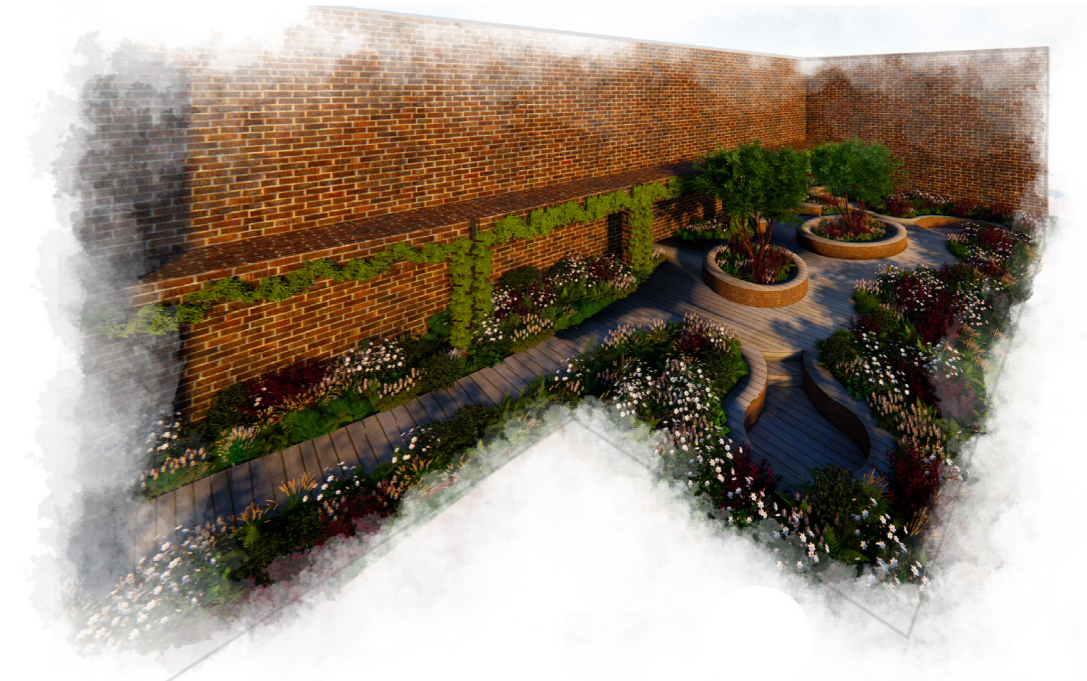

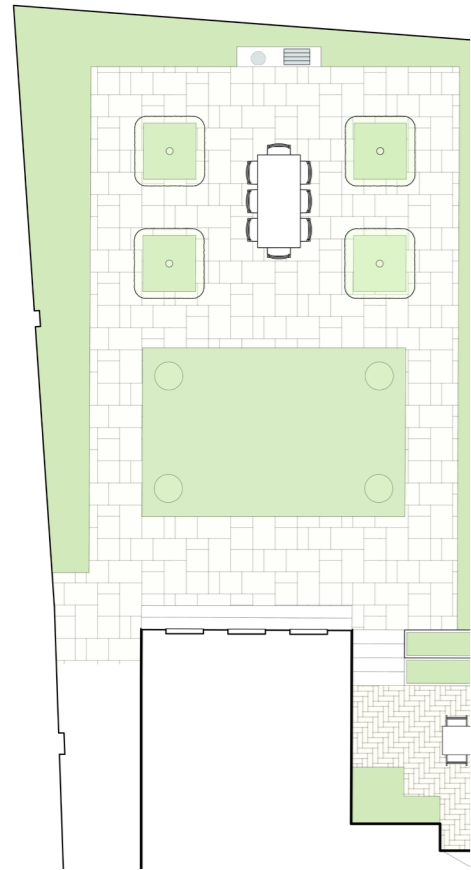
Visualisation of the Courtyard in late Summer

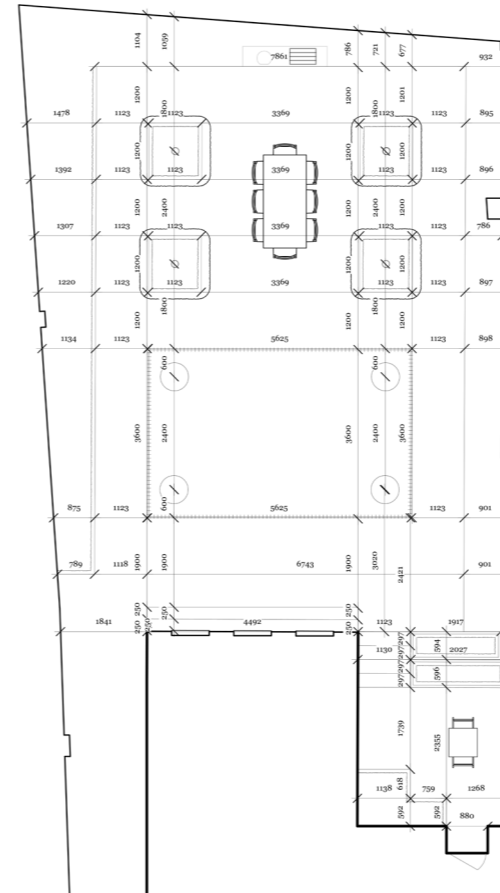


General Arrangement Plan

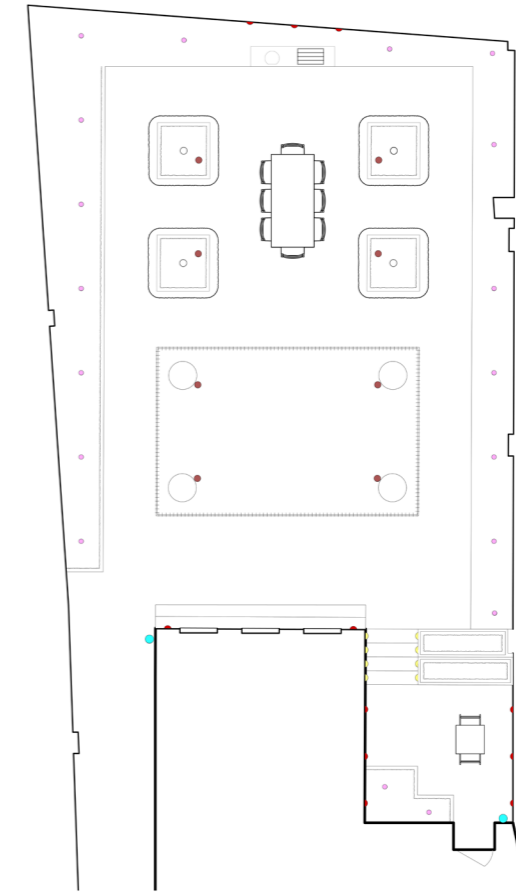

-  200x48x38mm Derby Clay Pavers from London Stone laid with 10mm joints filled with resin mortar coloured to match pavers in Herringbone Pattern. Refer to construction drawings.
-  Outside Kitchen Area. Refer to construction drawings.
-  900x500x40mm Jura Beige Smooth Limestone Bullnose Step laid with 10mm joints filled with resin mortar coloured to match paving with bond bridge. Refer to construction drawings.

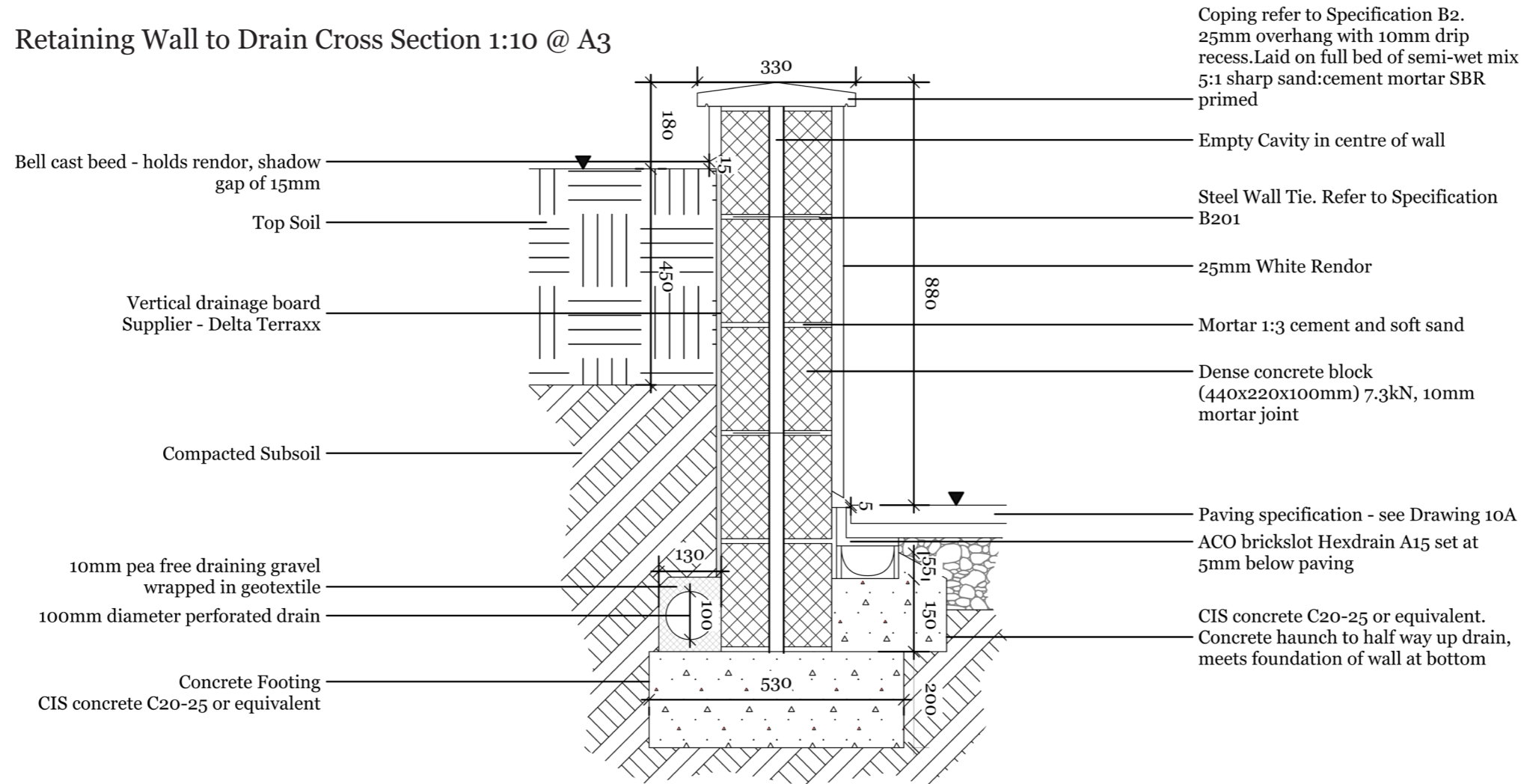

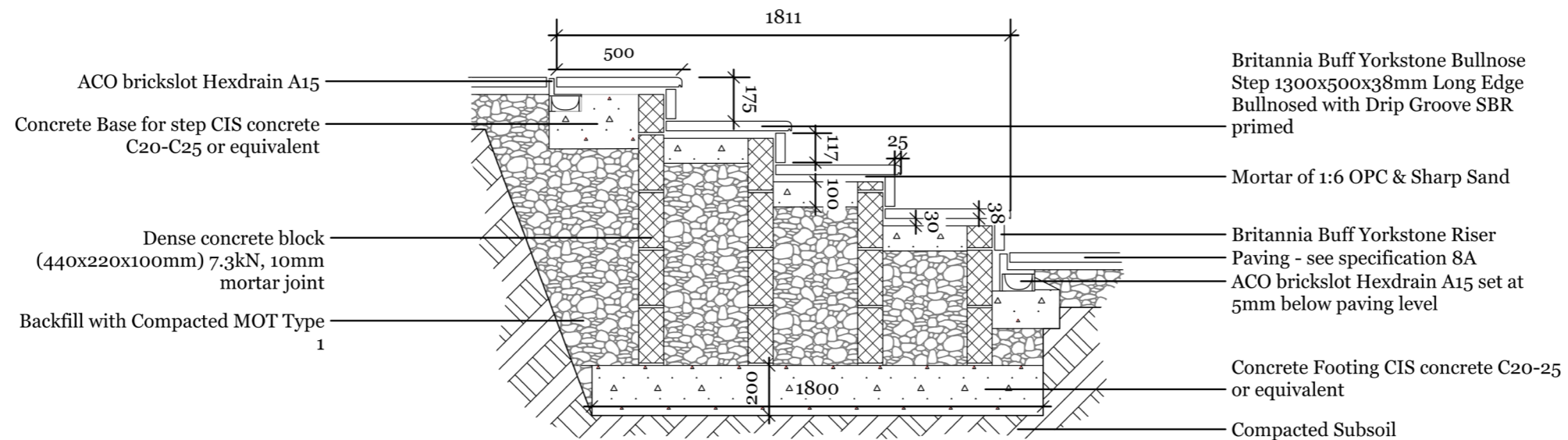
