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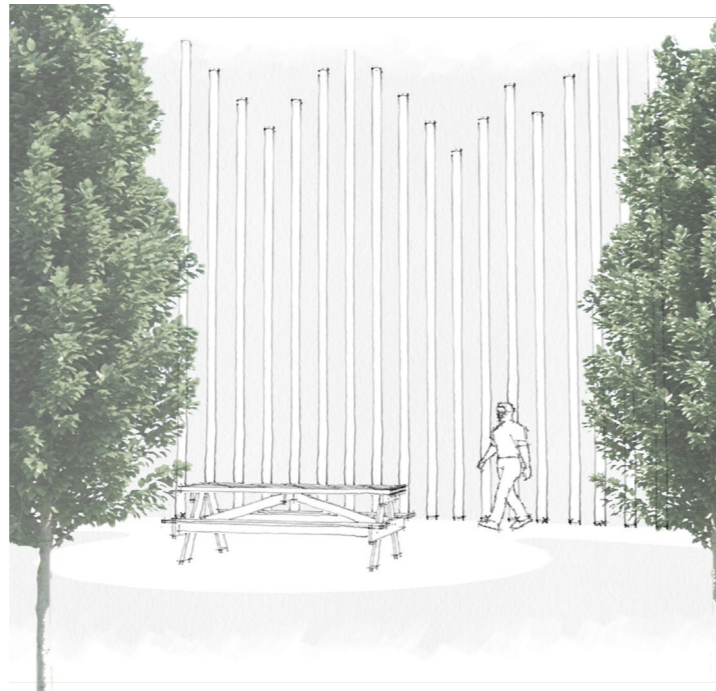
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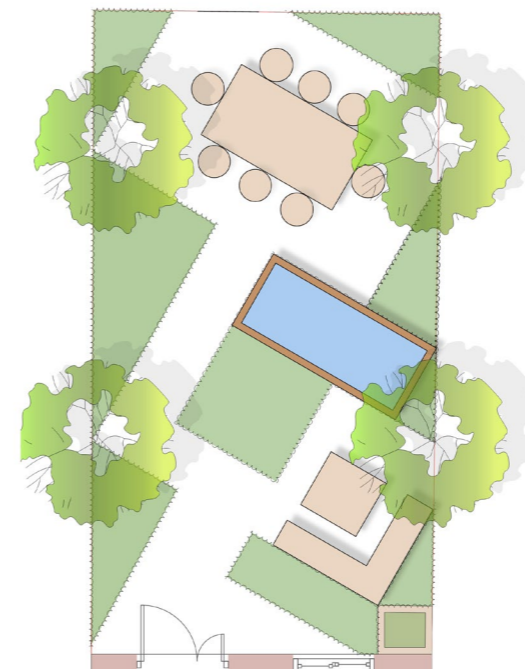
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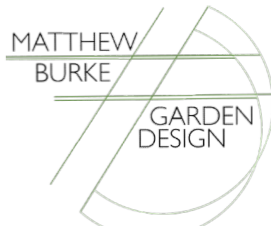
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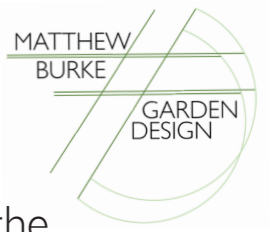
PROJECT 1 | THE ISOKON | HISTORIC RESIDENTIAL



Visual to showcase my garden for The Isokon Building, a grade 1 listed building in Belsize Park, London.

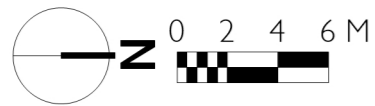
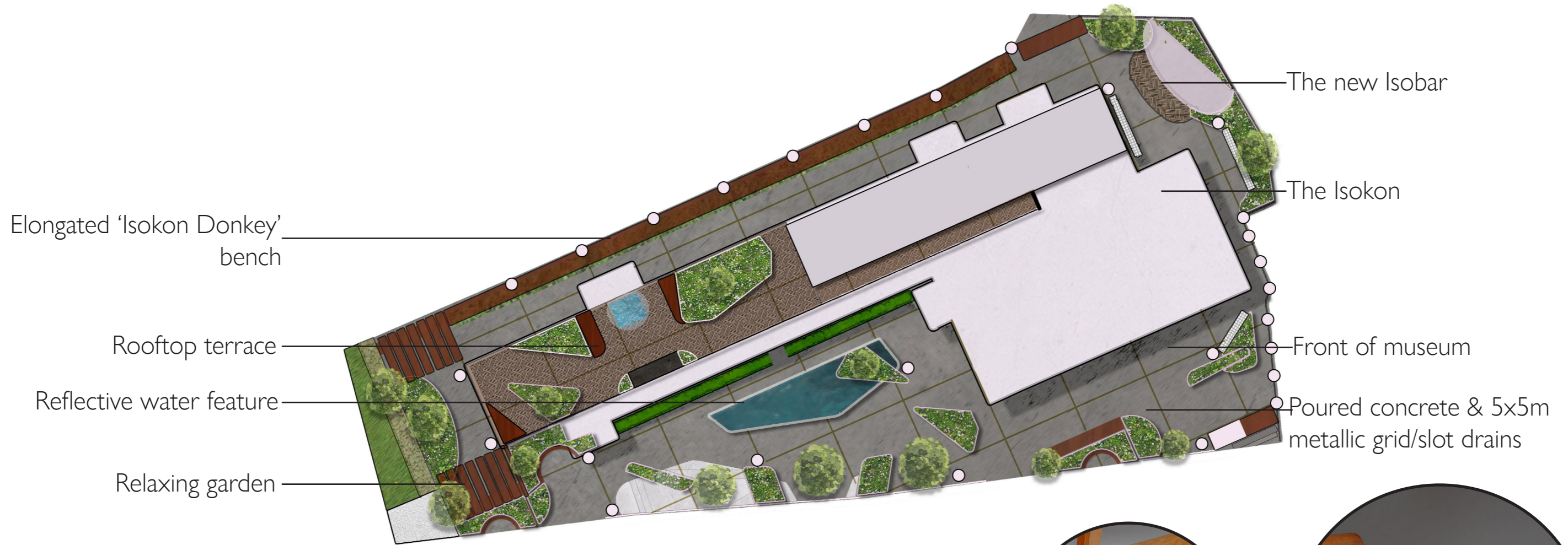


MASTERPLAN | THE ISOKON | HISTORIC RESIDENTIAL



BRIEF: Design new spaces for both residents and visitors for the grade 1 listed 'Isokon Building'

CONCEPT: The design gives residents and visitors gardens that do justice to the creators of The Isokon. Movement and objects are inspired by the innovations of the people who brought us the building such as The Isokon Long Chair, designed by Marcel Breuer, an early resident of The Isokon.

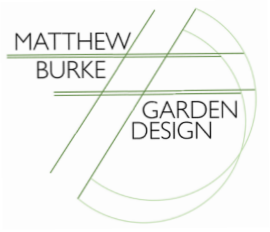
PROJECT 2 | PRIORY SCHOOL (QUAD) | PUBLIC REALM

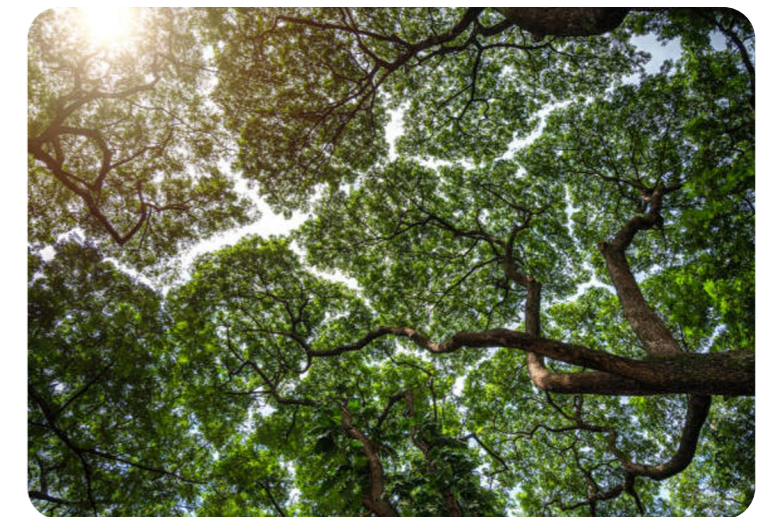
BRIEF: Redesign an underutilised large space within a secondary school in Lewes, Sussex.

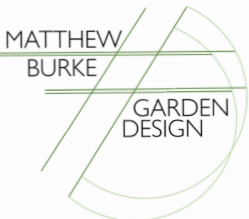

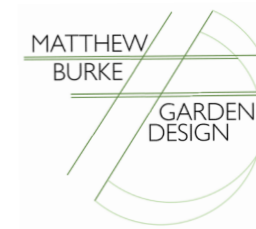
PROJECT 3 | PRIORY SCHOOL (COURTYARD) | THERAPUTIC

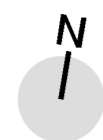


BRIEF: Create a calming outdoor space for teachers to take their breaks. This space is currently overlooked by classrooms.

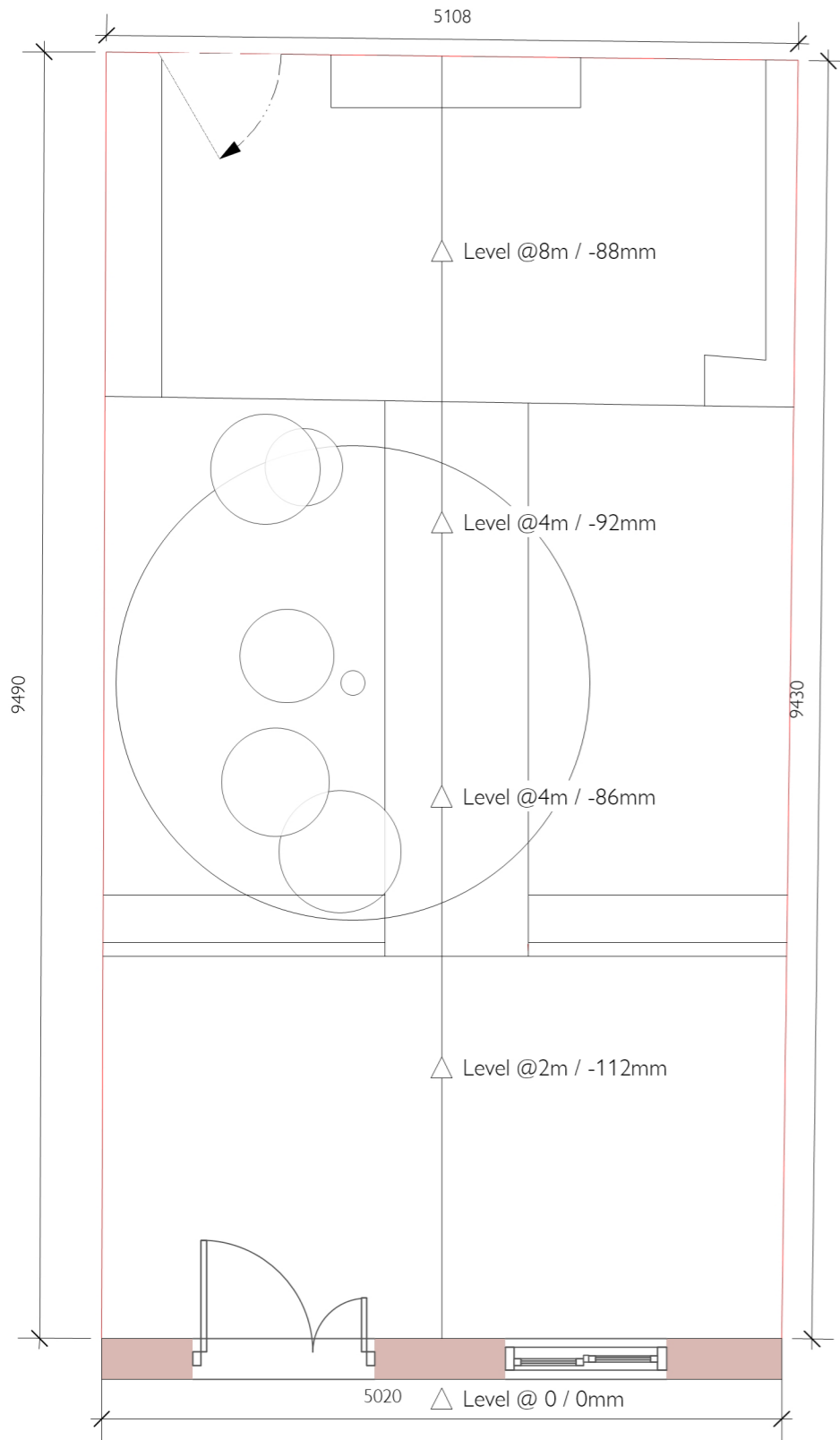

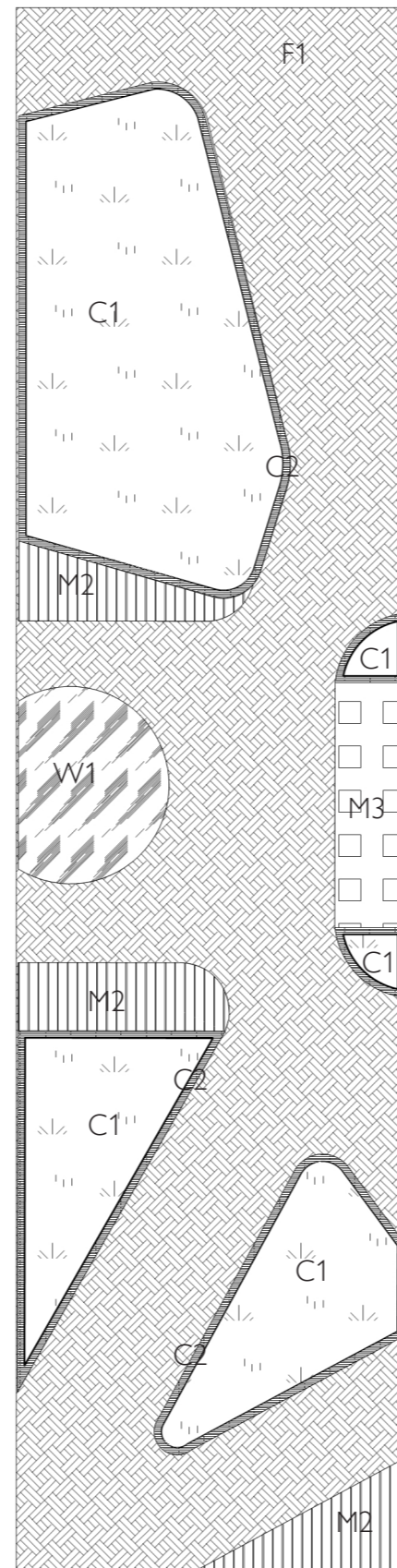

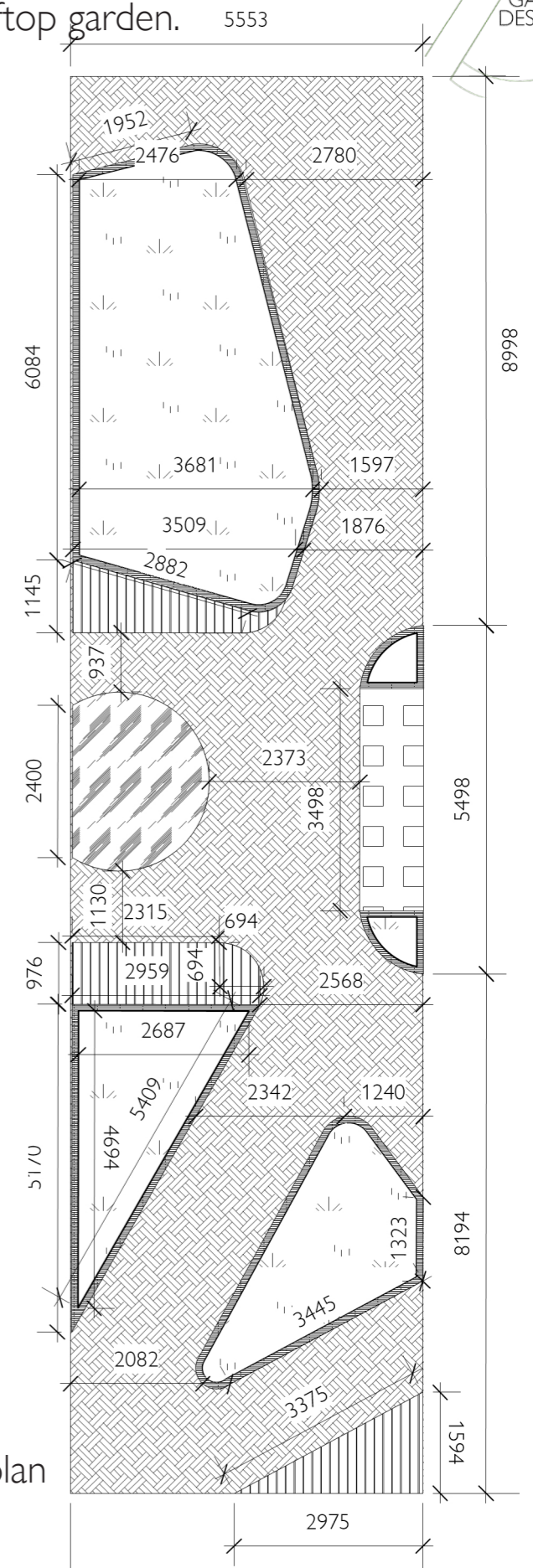

-  F1 Eco-friendly capped composite deck tile. Laid 2x2 307x307x22mm patchwork pattern at 45degree angles. See laying out plan
-  C1 Planting area of raised planter, see planting plans for plant layout.
-  W1 Bespoke water feature table
-  C2 Raised planter GRP (bespoke) to be made offsite and fitted in sections onsite.
-  M2 Bespoke bench storage unit
-  M3 Bespoke outdoor BBQ and unit - see separate spec from provider for accurate details

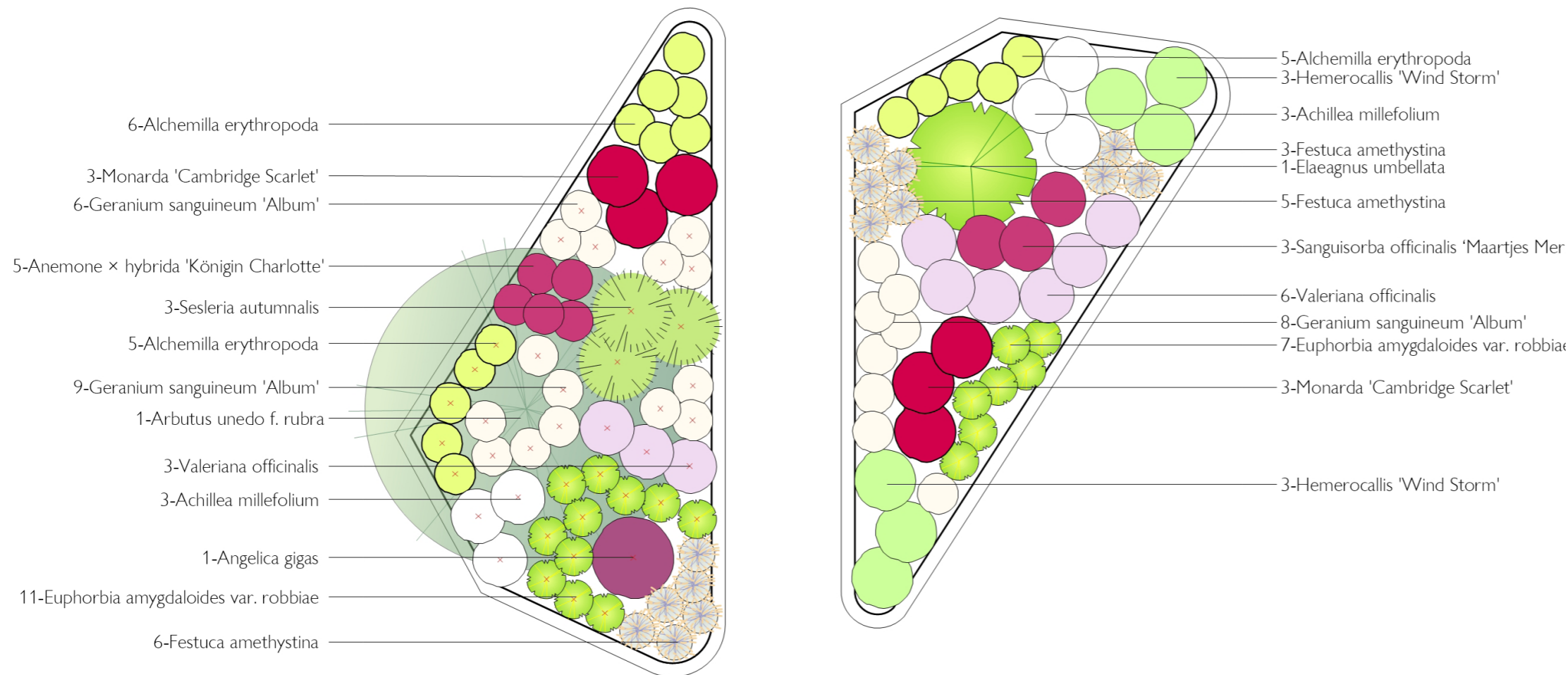

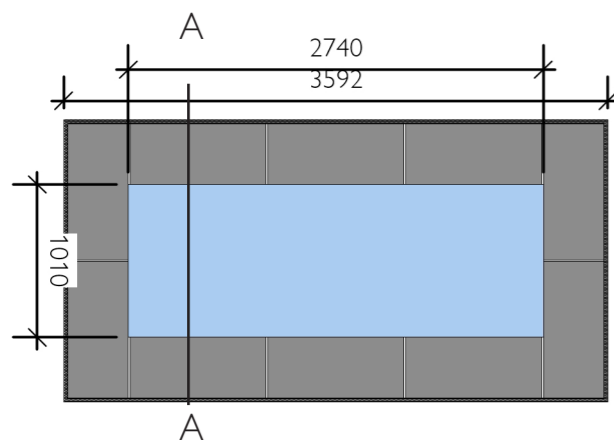
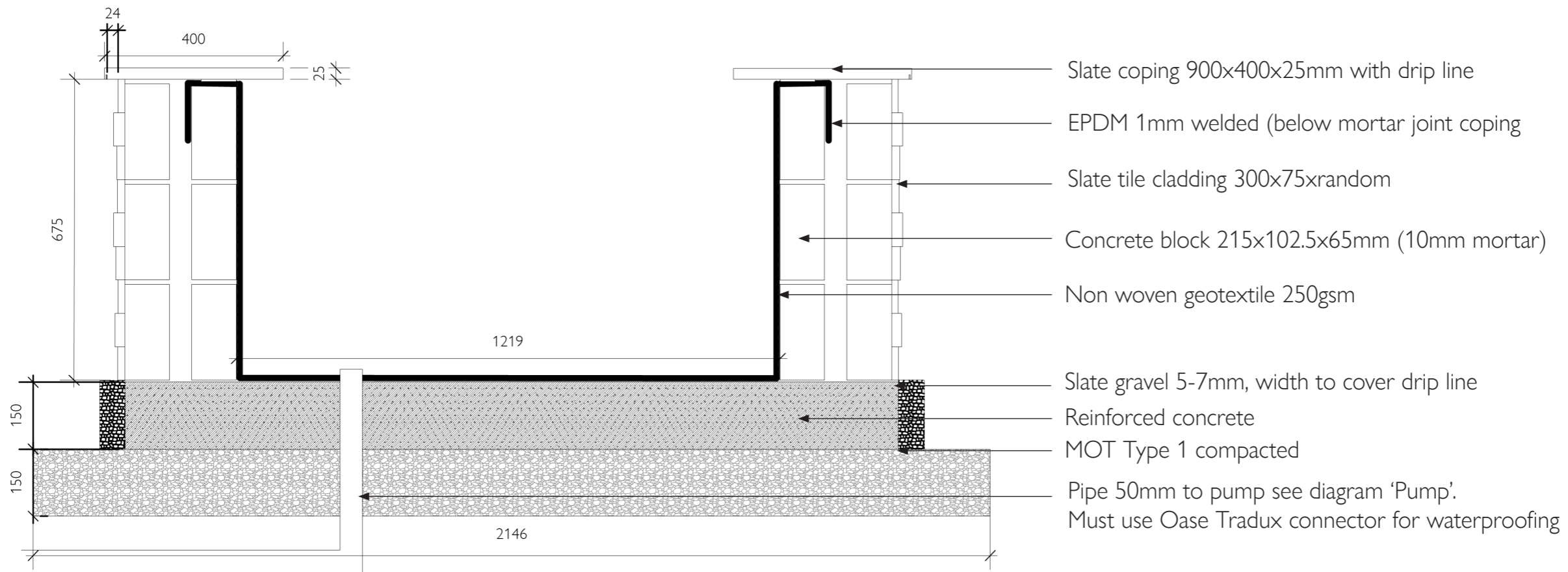

SKILLS | PLANTING PLAN

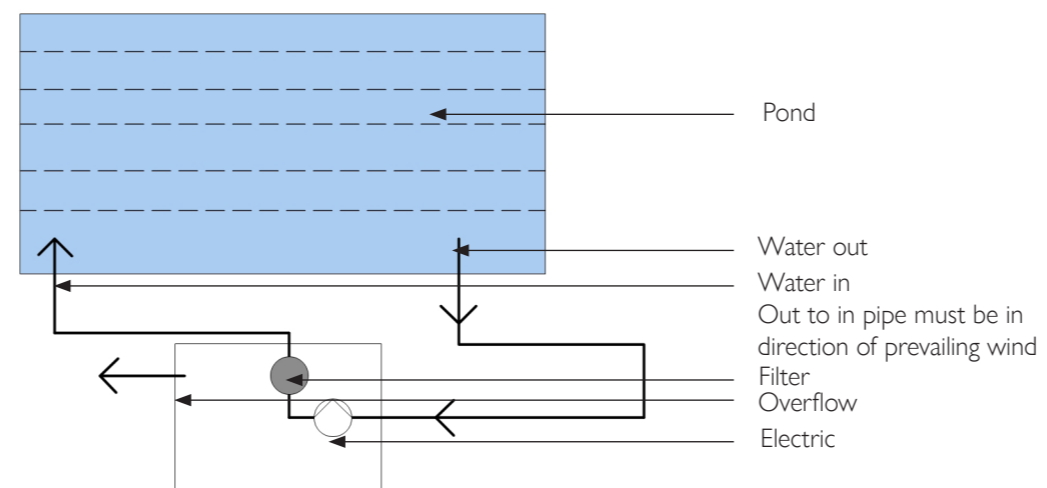

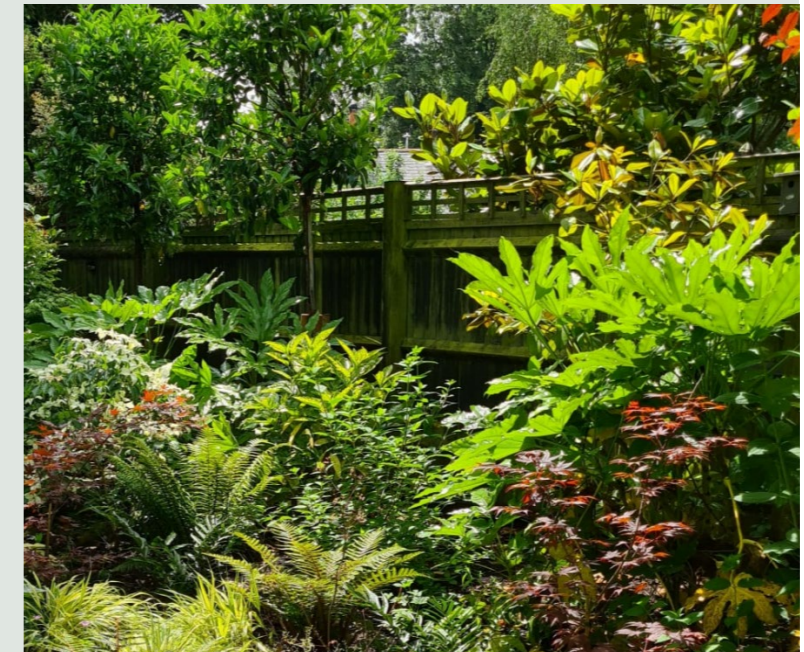
