
To create a socially, economically and environmentally sustainable space.


### Concept Design:

At the heart of West Dean, lives "English Eccentricity". The New Visitor Centre will incorporate the rich tapestry of the lives of the members of the James' family.



The client, "Community Brain", have requested a design for adaptable and sustainable spaces which encourage sharing, education, growth and enhance relationships between people and nature.


It is to include: events, pop-up markets, seating, a play area, co-working and an urban meadow.

#### Brief:


The Client has requested a partition wall separating the kitchen diner and home cinema room. Using the materials copper and walnut, to create a contemporary and sustainable design.


#### **Concept Design:**



The materials copper and walnut will be the focal point to the design and play on their individual properties to create a unique and timeless wall design.











Horizontal Section: Cinema & Firewall.



Bespoke Doors 3D: Cinema Room.





Vertical section: Cinema & firewall.






















## **RESIDENTIAL PROJECT**

#### Brief:

The client has an 125m apartment in Regents Park and requested to design 8 spaces. To include living/ cooking/ dining area/ master bedroom with en-suite, child bedroom with en-suite, guest shower room, work space, prayer room/ meditation and utility room.

### Concept Design:

The concept is to create harmony within the interior through geometric and abstract forms to bring the greenery of the surrounding park into the space through Biophilic design.
