
To design a perfume boutique store for a Britishly owned brand.


Creating a multi use space for commercial use with retail, cafe, work and shopping space in a two storey building.



To create a detailed working drawing of a reception desk for multi purposes.

Description


Creating a warm and inviting place that can by beacon in any store or retail space it was key to choose complimenting materials such as oak and slate. It was to be solid and a place for people to rely on.

Skills

Autocad, detailed working drawing, material matrix, research, Photoshop, Isometric drawings, SketchUp.



The structure will begin as an MDF plywood this will be joined together from screw fixes and will remain the same but for the WC access end of the desk at a height of 760mm and the 1500mm will be split in the centre at 750mm.
 On top of this will be an MDF substrate between the 1300mm structure, again with screw fixes.
 To cover will be the Reider Concrete Skin fibreC in the slate texture and in light grey, this will be fixed with adhesive across the substrate.

Merchant's Heart


To create a pop up space that was experiential for a commercial retail brand.



Take time to sit back and indulge in a joyful and premium spirit mixer, with a Merchant's Heart drinking experience: all while being surrounded by their rich history filled with nature, Japanese influence and the desire to produce exceptional produce.

Around 50% of Earth is covered in trees, solid yet peaceful, they stand together and through their own roots communicate for nutrients, safety and to help one another in need. These networks offer an unbreakable bond that also reflect how much time each tree has spent growing and adapting in this world...

Our roots are the strength that makes us who we are, each being different and organic, and within this pop up store you will find three bars to test and try the tonics. Below and above will be long, winding lights that are interchangeable between pinks, blues, greens and yellows. In the centre of the store a golden scripture will taint the stand for each guest to learn about Merchant's Heart roots and the importance they serve. Hanging above these are Japanese lanterns made from the traditional washi paper.

To design a residential home for a young professional female client in London with space for others to stay temporarily.


Description

A soft and airy space was created to be inviting for new guests but remaining homely for permanent residents. A neutral colour palette with reliable and comfortable materials in place.

Bathroom Finishes Proposal:

The bathroom was designed to create a sanctuary and a welcoming space for all kinds of rituals. My client has many early mornings, and the intention was to make these more enjoyable, easier and overall a better experience for her day to day. The color palette is very neutral with added elements of wood and plenty of greenery to create an atmosphere of 'zen.' The bath and shower will be combined with a glass grid screen, the toilet will be wall mounted with a concealed cistern to keep the space clean. As the bathroom will also be shared with one other roommate and other visitors, there will be two basins available with storage underneath. Within the shower will be internal shelving for extra health and beauty products this is also saving space for storage on the ground.




Finish 1: The shower and bath will be combined as to allow for more space elsewhere in the bathroom. I have chosen to keep it very simple with the contrast of a black screen and a porcelain tiled bath. The shower will have the option to be controlled via other devices elsewhere in the home to allow for optimal morning experiences!

Finish 2: These 'All Modern- Madeline Tiles' will be used above the basins and within the shower area to create extra texture without overpowering the space. They include different shades of cream and warm greys which, with the natural light, can reflect during the daytime.


Finish 3: The 'Abbotsbury Crema Porcelain' tiles from ArtisansofDezives will run across the whole bathroom floor with underflooring heating below them too, they are large and soothing with slip resistance. They compliment the rest of the space nicely to keep the attention based on the wooden features of the basins.

Finish 4: There will be two 'Veneto Basins' within the bathroom to accommodate for the users and each will be underneath a large LED mirror. The wooden finish was chosen to be inkeeping with the idea of zen and adding areas of nature to the bathroom, the taps will also have a matt black finish as shown here.

Finish 5: The toilet will be wall mounted as to be sleek and clean, I found by having a concealed cistern it fitted a cleaner appearance. Above the toilet will also be a small shelf in which the cistern will be hidden that can offer extra space for products.


