The concept of "Rooted In Nature" embodies a slower pace of life that values living in harmony with the natural world, creating wellness through biophilic design principles while honouring the property's history.



To enhance a sense of luxury, first floor bedrooms feature in-room baths and bio-ethonal stoves.


A yoga studio and meditation room were implemented to provide opportunities for wellness activities.


Pop-Up Retail Store (10sqm) Westfield Shopping Centre, London






The concept "*Preservation*" reflects ECO's commitment to protecting life, the planet, and natural resources through purposeful human intervention.

The portable pop-up store reflects ECO's sustainability ethos with a lightweight, modular design for easy setup and relocation. Tree-inspired forms and use of recycled plastics highlight the brand's commitment to reforestation and ocean clean-up efforts.




The store's position on a lower-floor provided potential to draw in foot traffic from the upper-levels due to a clear top-down view of the store. Rotating canopies with LED strips direct light onto the display units below.






